Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

If some of you came expecting to see Christmas decorations, make sure you come next week. Each year we follow the liturgical calendar and this year there is a Sunday between Thanksgiving and the first Sunday of Advent. Unlike the stores and commercials, we will begin our Christmas holiday decorations next Saturday, December 1st. Anyone who would like to come and help with the decorating, we would love to have you.

Many of the decorations will be similar to years past, but some will be different. I guarantee they will be beautiful and reflect not only Christmas, but the theme of **Advent as well. The theme for this Advent Season will be "Fear Not: Listening to the Angels of Advent."** We will take a close look at the messengers who spoke to Zechariah and told of John's birth, the angels who proclaimed the birth of Jesus to both Joseph and Mary, and finally the angels that shared the good news with the shepherds near Bethlehem.
