Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

February is the month dedicated to love: St. Valentine's Day, Hallmark Cards, sappy poetry, and chocolates! But true love is not about cards or roses, it's about God's feelings for each of us and God's expectations about our feeling toward each other.

The word, "love" has been abused, misused, and not used when it should be.
The Greeks had many different words for our one word "love." Those mentioned on the internet are:

Jan Yandell "Eros, named after the Greek god of fertility, and it represented the idea of sexual passion and desire...

...Philia or friendship, which the Greeks valued far more than the base sexuality of eros...

...While philia could be a matter of great seriousness, the word *ludus* is used to describe this form of love, which concerns the playful affection between children or casual lovers...

...Perhaps the most radical, was *agape* or selfless love. This was a love that you extended to all people, whether family members or distant strangers. *Agape* was later translated into Latin as *caritas*, which is the origin of our word "charity..."

...Pragma is about making compromises to help the relationship work over time, and showing patience and tolerance...

...And *philautia* or self-love. And clever Greeks such as Aristotle realized there were two types. One was an unhealthy variety associated with narcissism, where you became self-obsessed and focused on personal fame and fortune. A healthier version enhanced your wider capacity to love." (www.yesmagazine.org)

Lumping all of these feelings into one English word seems ludicrous. When Jesus spoke of loving one's neighbor, he was speaking about "agape" love for truly it was selfless and was to be given to all people. When Paul was writing to the Corinthians the word he used was also "agape."

As we begin the month of February and look ahead to the many things happening in our world. May we show "agape" love to all.


