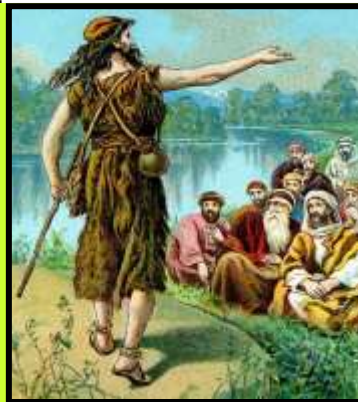


Last Sunday's Announcement
