Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Holy Week 2019 will strive to capture the excitement of the triumphal entry, the companionship of the Last Supper, the deep sadness of Good Friday, and the joy of Easter morning. It is like a roller coaster ride of faith because each of those sentiments are feelings we have in our own journeys. That is why it is so important to be present at each service during the week. It is difficult to understand the joy of Easter if you have not experienced the agony of Good Friday. And it is a struggle to understand the importance of the renewal Easter brings if you have not understood the separation felt in the loss of Jesus to his disciples that Thursday evening so long ago.

It is important to see the whole picture. Maybe it should be called "Wholey Week". We understand the whole picture of what God is doing through the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross and the awe and wonder of the empty tomb. We catch a glimpse of the importance of the whole story, not just the parts that are more palatable.

So this week I pray you will attend:

Maudy Thursday Service at 7:00 pm. We will share in community worship and then serve communion in Tables of 12. The Men's Chorus will be doing the special music in this meditative, Taize-like service.

Good Friday Service at 7:00 pm. The youth will once again build a live candle-lit cross as the story of the life and teachings of Jesus is told, then they will extinguish the candles as the Passion Story is read. The Chancel Choir will sing and a special gift of remembrance will be given to each as you leave the sanctuary.

Easter Son-Rise Service at 6:00 am. Banjo and guitar will lead this special service of celebration at the Veteran's Park Gazebo as we tell the story of the women who came to the tomb on Sunday morning, only to find it empty. The Lord is risen, He is risen indeed. Join us for the joy of the morning, be some of the first to proclaim the Risen Christ!

Joy-filled Easter Services at 8:30 and 10:00 am. Come hear the story once again as if hearing it for the first time. Celebrate the morning with beautiful music, and preaching from the gospel of Luke. Share in singing the "Hallelujah Chorus" and join the children for the Easter egg hunt. It is a day of thanksgiving and praise! Be there and celebrate the true meaning of our Christian faith.

Plan on making your week more holy and the story more whole.
