"Easter Instruction: Languish in the Love"

Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Do you realize that May comes on Tuesday? I don't know about you, but the fact that winter has lasted long into this month, it hardly seems possible that it is soon to be May already! Sometimes things just don't seem right, they just don't seem real, but regardless of what things seem, their reality is true.

Today we have two young men talking about acceptance and the overarching theme of the day that God is love. For many people, accepting others is a challenge, their understanding of love is that we love those we know, those we like, and those who are like us. That is not what the scripture implies today. That is not what John was proclaiming when he wrote this letter.
