This Holy Week will be different than any I have ever experienced. But that does not mean it is not Holy Week!

Today is Palm Sunday and we are singing our loud Hosannas as Jesus rides into Jerusalem. I have never been to Jerusalem, but I can use my imagination and see him and his disciples approaching the grand city. Palm leaves were waving and people were throwing their cloaks on the ground to honor the coming King.

Today, use your imagination, take a walk outside, wave your hands at your neighbor, shout "Hosanna", and make them wonder what you are up to! Celebrate the King of Kings wherever you are and then remember that he and he alone knew what would happen later in the week.

But, we know the whole story now and we need to remember those events and the sacrifice Jesus made for each of us. We will be remembering them in different ways, but WE MUST REMEMBER THEM!

Maundy Thursday: 1-3 pm AND 5-7 pm. **Drive up the church's driveway (from the Square) and tell the first table how many adults and children you have in your household.**

Drive to the next station and receive a bag with the number of pre-packaged Communion kits you need.

Also in the bag will be a reminder of Good Friday when Jesus died on the cross for our sins.

If you have children in your household then stop at the last table to receive an Easter activity bag for each child.

The greatest care will be given to assure safety for all. Items will be handled with gloves when packed and distributed.

We will celebrate Easter separately on the 12th, but we will celebrate Easter again when we all return to worship together.
