Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

During the season of Lent we have been singing a call to prayer entitled, **"Lord, Listen to Your Children Praying."** I chose this song for the Lenten Season because the words are simple and yet so important. All too often we pray for things for ourselves or other people; we pray for health and well-being. These are not bad things for which to pray. However, the song requests the Holy Spirit to come among us to grant us love, power, and grace.

Most of us have the resources we need to make our lives reasonably comfortable; our occasional illnesses or injuries usually do not incapacitate us too much. **But what we do need every day, every minute is God's Holy Spirit in our lives to guide and direct us on our paths. And with the Spirit comes God's love, with which we can care for others beyond our human capacity. An overflowing of compassion comes when God's love and our willingness to use it combine. The Spirit also sends us power to accomplish God's will for our lives. We need that extra push of strength and courage to be on the mission God calls us to complete. And lastly, the Holy Spirit sends God's grace. Grace is that undeserved blessing of forgiveness and patience that understands our humanness and loves us despite our inadequacies.**
