Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

What a joy it is to have our young people share their mission experiences with us today. The memories of our week together in Vermont and traveling are still fresh and the photos just reinforce the thought of fun and hard work that went into the mission.

42 youth and adults went on the mission trip this year. They represented the following churches:

- Painesville UMC – 13 youth and 9 adults
- Hope Ridge UMC – 10 youth and 2 adults, with 1 who had to stay home due to injury.
- Shoregate UMC – 1 youth, 2 young adults, and 1 adult
- East Shore UMC – 1 young adult
- Willoughby UMC – 1 youth
- North Mentor Centenary – 1 youth
- Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church – 1 youth

The planning for the trip began in November, skipped December, and then continued the last Sundays of January through May. This is a "Youth Owned-Youth Designed" Mission Program which means the youth make the plans and all major decisions; they are responsible for menus, finances, and travel accommodations. They develop worship booklets and create the travel and work teams themselves. The adults are basically along to drive vans, use credit cards, and help with the work. WE are very much like a family!! Please join us for the luncheon in Parsons Hall following the 10:00 service. Ask questions about the trip and listen to more stories. A donation of at least \$5.00 would be appreciated if you were not a stockholder from this year's trip. Stockholders receive their lunch in gratitude for their support.

We will begin planning Mission 2020 beginning November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019 from 6-8pm!! Join us!!
