Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

The definition of "Persistence" is "The quality of continuing steadily despite problems or difficulties." Today's story is about a widow who had problems or difficulties dealing with a judge when it came to a matter of justice.

We don't know what the problem was, but it must have been very important to her, because she never gave up. Jesus told this parable to help the disciples understand that they needed to be persistent in prayer when it comes to matters of heavenly justice. The parable certainly speaks to us today.

In case you haven't realized by now, Jesus was also a persistent teacher. He continued through each of his parables to promote justice for the people who had been downtrodden in their lives. Widows were among the poorest of the poor. In Jesus time, wives were property of their husbands and if their husband died, and they had no children, they had no resources for survival except begging.

The widow's voice was not heard, or at least it was not one to which the judges listened. But her persistence paid off! She never gave up, and the judge finally gave in! Jesus is **telling us to be as diligent as she in matters of justice. Let us never give up, for Jesus' sake!**
