Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

"We Are Climbing Jacob's Ladder" is an African American spiritual taken from the story in Genesis 28:10-21 about Jacob and his dream. The origin of the song is not known, but probably came from slaves brought from Africa and was used as a call to discipleship and courage as they faced the trauma of the American slave trade and oppression.

The call and response nature of the hymn with its echoing of the words gave a cadence and a feeling of community while singing in the fields. When we think of the angels ascending and descending on the ladder, we may ponder what it means. For the songwriters, singers, and for us today, the meaning of drawing closer to God ourselves and knowing that God's messengers are surrounding us both in heaven and on earth is comforting.

May this story bring meaning to your life and your dreams and be a blessing to you.

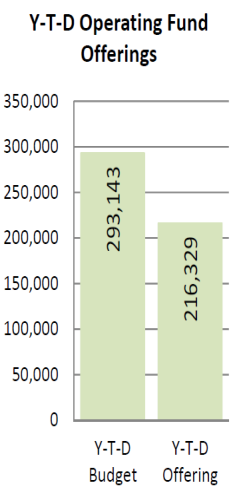
