Bring your gifts next Sunday, Dec. 16.

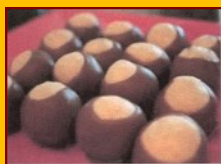
Do not wrap the gift, but attach the ornament with its label so we know who it is for.
