Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

When I was with a youth work mission team cleaning up Cedar Rapids, Iowa after the Mississippi River dumped 12 feet of water over the city, the then bishop of the Iowa Conference, Gregory Palmer, came to visit the flooded area. I had worked with Bishop Gregory Palmer for 5 years in Berea and it was wonderful to see him again, even in such a devastated setting.

A photographer that travelled with him took our picture and stated, "You must be exhausted, taking care of 40 missionaries and working in such deplorable conditions!" Before I could answer her, Bishop Palmer chimed in saying, "Don't worry about Jan, this is what feeds her soul!"

Bishop Palmer knew me well. Youth work missions do feed my soul. Though the situation **was difficult, working with the youth and adults and serving God's people who were in a state of loss and despair did indeed feed my soul.**

So what does the feeding of our soul have to do with joy? Joy is that powerful sense of fulfillment and energy one gets from doing what God has called them to do. Joy can be sensed by people who are doing the things that fill their souls. Joy emanates from the very heart when one is accomplishing the purpose God has created for them. So, what is it that feeds your soul? What is it that brings you joy? If it is not what you are doing, then do something else, life is too short!! Find your joy, fill your soul, and rejoice in the Lord always!

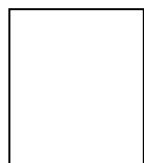
PUMC's 1st Annual Trunk or Treat Sunday October 29th from 5-7pm
