Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

How horrified we all were last week, when we found out about the shooting in Las Vegas. It was yet another example of someone who senselessly took the lives of innocent people. I have pastored to people who have lost loved ones by suicide or in tragic accidents, but have not in 28 years of ministry had to deal with a family who suffered loss at the hands of another. I suppose I should prepare myself as the world seems to be creating more people who have little regard for human life, until then I continue to pray for those involved, as well as their families and strive to work for social justice and peace in the world.

Paul in this very scripture uses one of my favorite lines, "...but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me." I must continue to pursue perfection in the loving of all people, because it was by that perfect love of Christ, I have been forgiven of my sins and saved to serve God. That perfect love took hold of me 45 years ago and has never let go. That perfect love pushes me to press on with the message of forgiveness and compassion until all the people in the world understands that "the other person" is equal to, if not better than ourselves and each living breathing soul is a beloved child of God.

Obviously, the shooter in Vegas, the hate mongers and war revelers of the world haven't gotten that message yet, therefore I and all others who follow Christ must "press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me (us)!" We must press on in our speech, our attitude, and our action. Then and only then, might the world know peace.

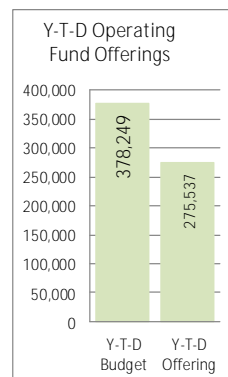

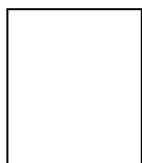
