Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Happy Easter! He is risen, He is risen, indeed!

Every year for 30 years I have preached on Easter Sunday. Yet, it never gets old. The gospels tell the story each with their own spin, but the message is the same! What once was there was gone, what once was gone is back; gone from the tomb, back from death. Jesus Christ is risen and the world now lives in the promise of resurrection and everlasting life. It is an amazing story, that I never tire of telling!

Jesus was born to a young maiden, consecrated in the Jewish Temple, and worked in his **father's carpenter shop. But this was not why he was born, nor what he was born to do.** Jesus began his preaching around the age of 30, he gathered a few disciples, healed the sick, and taught about the love God had for the world. This was part of his purpose, but certainly not all of it. His popularity grew, the crowds followed him anxious to hear every word he said, and those who opposed him, struggled with those words and with his actions. Jesus was arrested, crucified, and died on a Roman cross. But that was not the end of the story. He died for our sins and rose for our sake. He proved that death was not as strong as the life he lived and promised us. That is why he was born, that is why he lived, that is why he died, and that is why he lives again. That is the Easter message. 30 years and it never gets old!

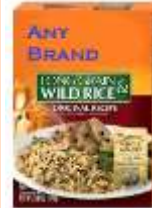
