**Today's scripture is another one of my gazillion favorites! The thing I love most about it is the way Jesus unexpectedly shows up when folks are having a lousy day, and asks them for a favor. If you notice, Jesus first asked to borrow the boat so he could teach more people on the shore. After the teaching, he noticed the catch for the day was pretty pathetic and then he returned the favor. "Throw your nets on the other side!" That's all he said. After first complaining, they did and the nets were full to overflowing!**

Then, after the best fishing haul of their careers, Jesus asks them to drop everything, follow him and begin "catching people!" **What a great story of what we all must be ready to do when Jesus calls: follow directions, be amazed, drop it all, and follow him! Jesus doesn't make our decision to follow him easy, but it is still the best decision you will ever make in your life.**
