"The Difference: All to Hear or God to Hear"

Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

As we continue the Season of Lent, today we take a hard look at prayer. Jesus again is contrasting what he would like us to do with what others tend to do. Again in this scripture he speaks of what is happening in the synagogues and on the street corners. Those seem to be the places where almsgiving and prayers are seen by others.

Prayer, like the giving of alms should be done secretly, so that God alone hears your personal conversation. Because that is what it is, a casual conversation with your creator who loves you more than you will ever know. It should be like talking with your best friend. There should be time for speaking as well as time for listening. All too often we do all the speaking and leave little time for God to respond. And that time is the most important part of the prayer.

Paul Chilcote, a Wesleyan Scholar and a friend, teaches prayer using the acronym: ARTIST. **He asks people to first give "Adoration" to God, then "Repent" of your sin, followed by giving "Thanks" for all the blessings showered upon you, then do "Intercessions" for others who need lifted up to God, and then he claims it is OK to pray for "Self-Help" and lastly to acknowledge your "Trust" in God.**

If you look closely, all six of these elements are in the prayer that Jesus taught his disciples in the scripture we are sharing this morning.
