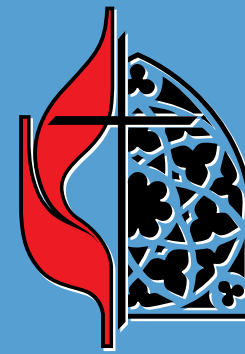

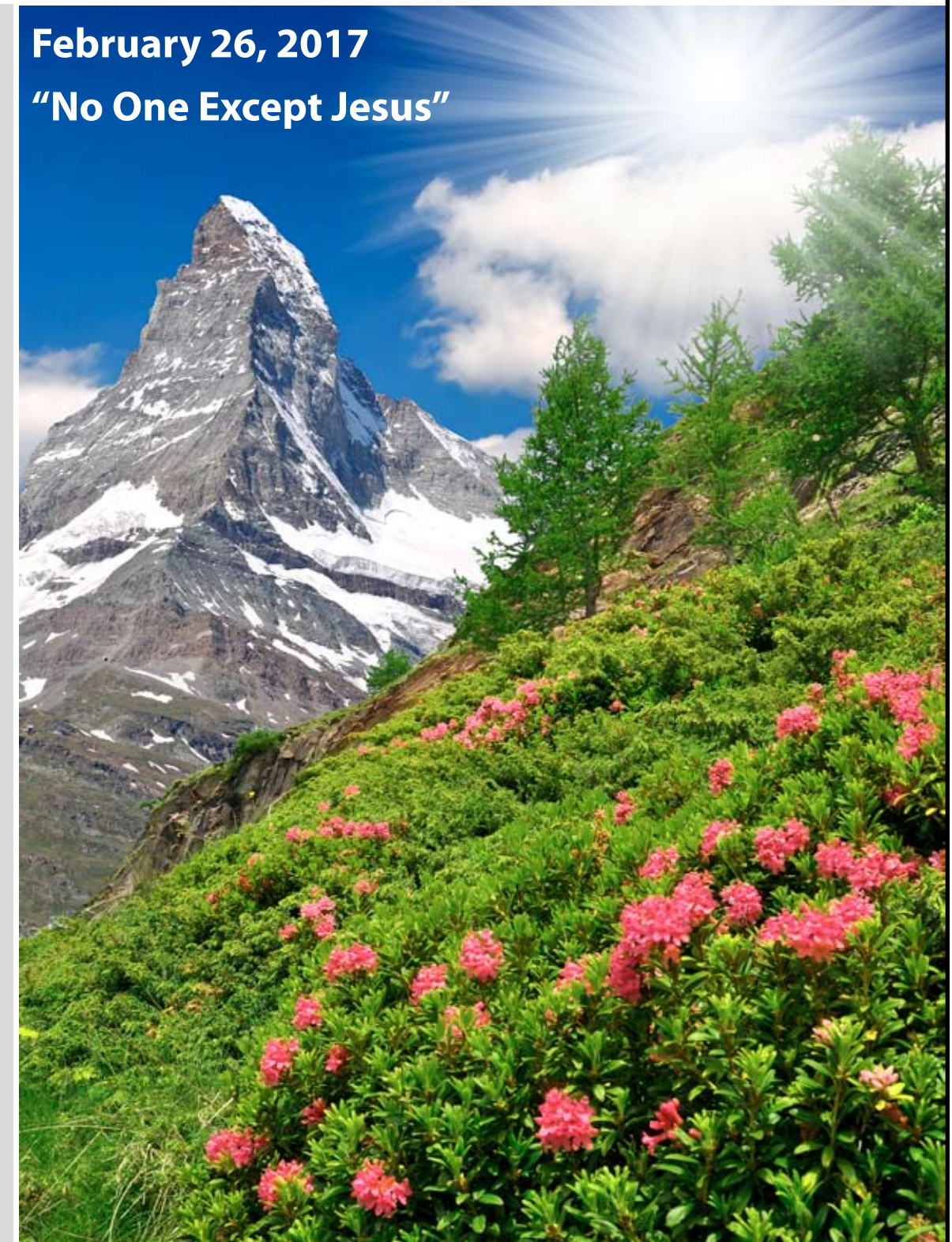

Following that presentation people worked in small groups to share words representing the values of the church and her mission. Those words can be seen on the foam hands in the Circle Room. Using those words, vision statements were created at each table and then refined with ideas that were common among the table groups. Below the Order of Worship you will find the Vision Statement that was voted to be the one to represent the spirit of the church as we look five years down the road.

The next job was to determine how we are going to get there and so each table created mission statements that showed the ways we intend to create the vision. All of the table groups, which were randomly selected, came up with some very good statements, but the one on the middle page of the bulletin seemed to capture both the practical and the spiritual aspects of our work together.

Once the Vision and Mission Statement were on paper, the members of a variety of committees worked together to create some action steps for their areas to take which would live into both statements. It wasn't an easy task, but I am so grateful to all who participated and brought so many wonderful thoughts to the mix.

Painesville United Methodist Church is an amazing place with incredible potential to become stronger and stronger as a community where all people can find the love of God and the peace of Christ.

Read the statements over a few times, grasp the spirit of them and the power they have for our future. Then, strive to do whatever you can do individually to move in direction of the mission with your eye on the vision of who we potentially want to be.

Today is Transfiguration Sunday, where Jesus turned toward Jerusalem to accomplish all that God had asked him to do. I pray our new vision will be one that will accomplish all that God is asking us to do as well.

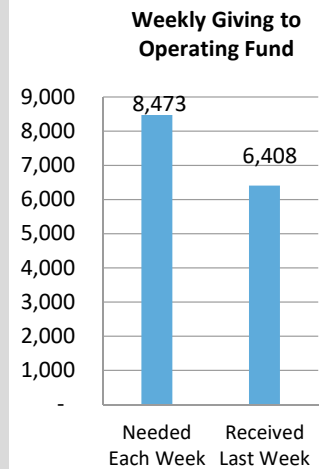
