Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Isaiah 43 is a wonderful chapter filled with hope and comfort. When selecting scripture for the season of Epiphany, which this year goes through March 3<sup>rd</sup>, I wanted clear simple scripture that produced a message of a single thing God is trying to help us understand. **Last week we spoke of "One Gift" in Jesus Christ our Lord. This week we hear of "One Promise" found in Isaiah 43:1 "...you are mine!" Over the next seven weeks we will be delving into what the Bible says about, "One People," "One Body," "One Love," "One Day," "One Lesson," "One Challenge," and "One Vision."**

You see, Epiphany is a funny season that is dependent on the timing of Easter. Six weeks prior to Easter is the Lenten Season and so the Epiphany Season can be as short as four weeks or, as is the case this year, as long as nine weeks. Do not worry, we will not be leaving the Christmas decorations up until March (though liturgically it would be ok to do so.) We will savor them until the end of January and have a different look as we prepare for the Lenten Season during February.

**Epiphany is from the Greek word "epiphaneia" which means a "manifestation, striking appearance, or sudden realization. It is a season of enlightening in which situations are seen or understood in a new way." (Wikipedia)** My prayer for you this Epiphany Season is that you open your hearts and minds to new realizations and discoveries that will deepen your faith in God and in humanity.
