Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

"Whatever affects one directly, affects all indirectly. I can never be what I ought to be until you are what you ought to be. This is the interrelated structure of reality." Martin Luther King, Jr.

When the Psalmist wrote that "All may find refuge in the shadow of your wings," he was referring to the shadow of the wings of the Lord. For those that are so anxious to change the "All" to "we" or the "Us" to "me" I would remind you that not one person on earth is exactly the same, and not one person on earth is inherently different. When the Bible reads "All," it means All!

The quote above gives me pause as I think of "All" and that "interrelated structure of reality". Imagine a group of people trying to stay in the shadow of God's wings. Think what will happen if one person moves in one direction. Either the entire group has to adjust or someone is going to be left out of the protective covering. If people are more concerned with wanting "all" to share in that protection and love which God wants so desperately to give to "all" then everyone must be pulling people in and finding room for "all" to fit, rather than pushing people out because it is more comfortable.

When Martin Luther King Jr. states that "I can never be what I ought to be until you are what you ought to be." (and the opposite is also true), we "all" must work together to determine what we "all" must be for the benefit of the world.

We can all fit in the shadow of God's wings, and God wants us all to be there!
