Coronavirus Updates for Church Opening

The Task force has determined that being a compassionate and care-giving community, our first concern must be for the safety and well-being of all in our congregation and visitors.

1. **PUMC will remain closed to in-person worship until further notice.** Please be patient!
2. PUMC must see a 14-day decline in the new cases of COVID-19 in the state of Ohio before beginning procedures to allow the church to re-open. We are still watching the trending carefully.
3. For the protection of all, everyone who enters the building will be required to wear a mask. Masks cut down on the transmission of the virus through droplets of moisture expelled from the mouth and nose. Please be considerate of others. Mask are available at church. It is just for one hour!!
4. The pews have been taped off with painter's tape. The downstairs will seat individuals or couples at the ends of every other pew. Families of 3 or more will sit in the balcony as the pews are longer up there!
5. Everyone will enter the building on the East Side (New county building side) Wooden doors or Atrium and enter the sanctuary through the east door nearest the women's restroom.
6. Everyone will exit through the main front doors (Veteran's Park side) and will be dismissed by aisles. Those needing the elevator will exit through the kitchen door toward the Circle Room.
7. We will Pass the Peace by waving, bowing, saluting, or other sign of greeting and respect.
8. Words to Call to Worship, Scripture, Hymns, and Songs will be displayed on a screen.
9. The Critical Factors weighing decisions are: trends of cases in Ohio; the number of people who normally worship with us; the preparation of the facility. Smaller groups are beginning to meet in the building as allowed by the state and the Bishop.
10. When we re-open there will be two services: **8:15** and **10:00!!!**
11. ****We will need –Thanks to those who have volunteered!!:** 6 ushers for both services, 2 greeters for the 2 East Doors, 6 Cleaners from the 8:15 service. Please call the church office 440-354-3642 to sign up to be an usher, a greeter, or a cleaner.
