Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Happy Father's Day! As with Mother's Day, I am inclined to celebrate a much wider group of men than those who are biological fathers. I do not diminish the role of biological fathers in any way, and I am very grateful for my own father who gave me life and loved me immensely in the short time we had together in this world. Because, he died when I was quite young, I have come to appreciate those men in my life with whom I shared special times and special relationships. And therefore celebrate them on this day, as well as my own father.

Dave McCracken was the son of Indiana University basketball coach Branch McCracken. He was also the basketball coach and a teacher at Greencastle High School when I was there. **Dave and the women's physical education teacher, Ann Lawver took a group of students on a canoe trip in the Boundary Water's between Minnesota and Canada. Dave paid for my brother, twin sister, and me to go.**

One evening on the trip, I was sitting on a rock listening to the sound of the waves lapping up on the shore, the crackle of the campfire, and began to cry thinking of how my father (a great outdoor enthusiast) would have loved the scene. Dave came up and sat beside me, asked what I was thinking about and I told him. He sat with me for a while, put his arm **around my shoulders and said, "If you ever need a father, I am here for you!"** He never knew how much that meant to me as a young teen, but when it came time for our wedding, Jim had his father and grandfather stand up with him and I called Dave McCracken to be his third groomsman. I needed a father and he was there.

I pray all of you men will keep your eyes open for someone in need of your presence in their lives; you all have the opportunity to be a father to someone! I thank God for all of you!
