The answer continues to be: "I don't know!" The Task Force met this Thursday, but I do not have any additions to the Updates at time of printing the bulletin on Wednesday.

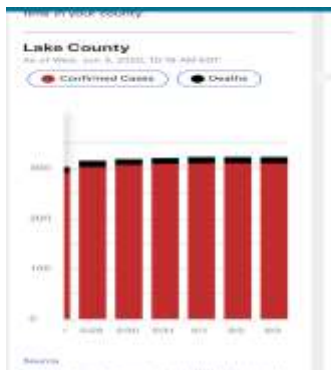

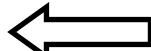
The Task force has determined that being a compassionate and care giving community, our first concern must be for the safety and well-being of all in our congregation and visitors.

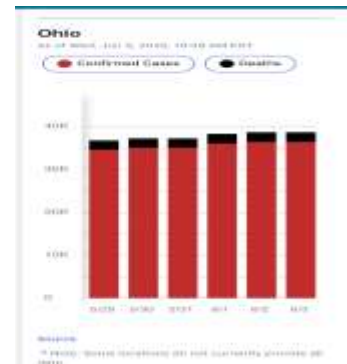
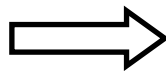
