Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Thanks to all who participated in the Ash Wednesday service this past week. I appreciate so much the beautiful music, the gracious love, and the spirit of healing and forgiveness. That is a spirit I am asking all to continue throughout the Lenten Season and beyond.

I invite anyone who would like to go and hear what Bishop Malone has to say this afternoon at 4:00 pm. She will be responding to the circumstances of General Conference and the options the church may have for the future. I will be driving over and can take as many as 14 others in the Walker Van. Let me know if you would like to go.

After the General Conference vote, I sent out an e-mail blast about my thoughts on the matter. If you did not receive that there are printed copies on the Volunteer Desk. The vote to maintain the Traditional language will not be complete until the Judicial Council has had a chance to review those parts that were first deemed unconstitutional. They will be meeting in April.

Please note that what I wrote before the conference still remains true.

**"I need to make it very clear that whatever is voted upon at the General Conference whether it be the One Church Model, the Traditionalist Model, or the Connectional Model, NOTHING WILL CHANGE THE WAY WE WORSHIP GOD in this church. ALL WILL ALWAYS BE WELCOME in this church. AND LOVE WILL PREVAIL OVER PREJUDICE AND BIGOTRY in this church."**
