Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

I think some people look at the act of worrying as a sport; one which needs to be practiced sufficiently and perfected to the nth degree. Sometimes people worry so much about the past (which cannot be changed) or about the future (over which they have little to no control) that they totally miss the joy of the present!

**It was always said in our family that "You can't worry about something you can do nothing about!" And let's be honest, that would be about 90% of our worrying.** The percentage is that high because if we could do something about it, we would not worry, we would just do it!
