Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,
As we enter into the second week in Lent, we meet a man named Nicodemus. He was a Pharisee, a teacher in the Jewish Temple. Yet, he was intrigued by Jesus and his teaching. He had questions which could not be answered by the scriptures he knew so well. So he sought out Jesus by cover of night.

There are many who know the written word. They can memorize scripture and quote it verbatim. They can use the Bible to justify almost anything. But words on a page or quotes on the tongue are not nearly as important as understanding what they mean and how to put them to work in your daily life.

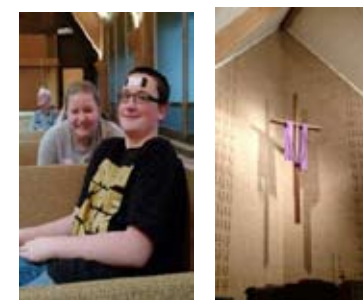
It is when the scriptures are put to use serving the people God has placed in your pathway that the Holy Spirit becomes alive in you. Being a "Born Again" Christian is about allowing the Spirit to lead your faith walk, to guide you on the path God has chosen for you.

Have you gone to see "The Shack" yet? It is also about searching for answers to questions that cannot be answered easily, but it is also about finding God in the midst of that search. Yes, it is just one person's interpretation of God, but it is filled with Biblical nuances and brings the gospel to a place most people can find accessible. If you have read the book, you will be pleased that the movie makers have done a wonderful job staying true to the story.

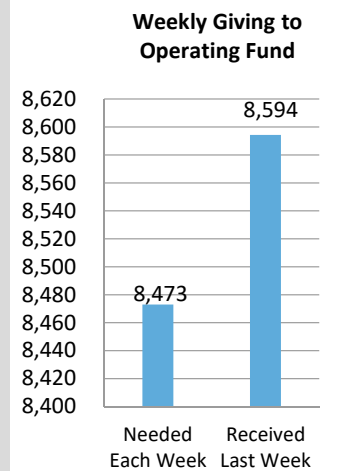
