If you notice, I selected the hymn, "This is the Day of New Beginnings" for our opening hymn. Bishop Tracy S. Malone, resident bishop of the East Ohio Conference, shared that the much-needed dormitory will provide a safe, secure environment, and a community of support on a campus where the newest residence hall was completed in 2004.

Our 6-week Lenten project began on February 26th. PUMC hopes to provide funds to purchase 44 doors for the dormitory at a cost of \$3,080. So open your heart, open your wallet, and let's open some doors for Africa University's new dorm!
