Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Top of the morning to you! Happy St. Patrick's Day. Did you know that St. Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland? Well of course you did! But did you know that he was born in England and was kidnapped when he was 16 and spent 6 years in prison before going to school to become a priest. He went to Ireland to serve the people who had already converted to Christianity and to bring more people on board. To do this, he took some of the Irish pagan practices and adapted them to Christianity to help people in converting on familiar terms. (ie. He used fire in many of his services and put the symbol of the sun on what is now known as the Irish Cross.)

St. Patrick did not drive the snakes out of Ireland as is one of the myths surrounding him. The water surrounding the island of Ireland is too cold for reptiles to venture in, but the story is used as a symbol of how he chased wickedness from the land.

The symbol of the green shamrock was also used by St. Patrick to describe The Trinity of Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The singular stem separating into three different leaves, just as God is one singular entity known in three different ways.

As we continue our study of "The Psalms and the Savior," we are looking at the ways God draws us close, lifts us up, teaches us God's ways, and gives us courage and strength. Jesus, God's son, exemplified Psalm 27 throughout his life on earth and continues to lead us through the Holy Spirit.

So today, *May the sun always shine On your window pane.
May a rainbow be certain To follow each rain
May the hand of a friend Always be near you.
May God fill your heart with gladness to cheer you.*
