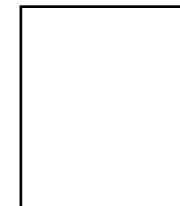

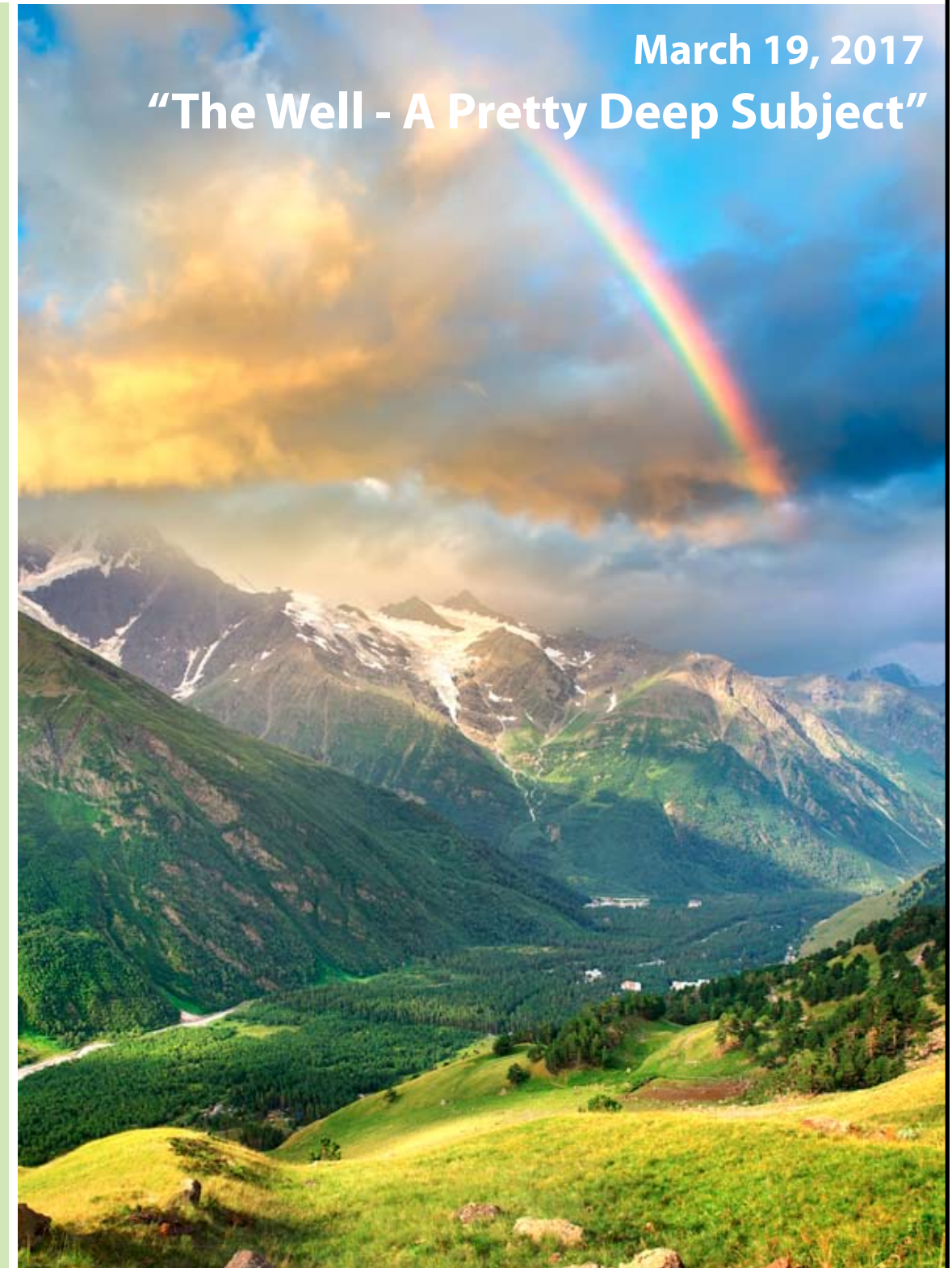

# PJ's Post

Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Today's story takes place at a well outside the city of Sychar. It is called Jacob's well, as it is on the land Jacob left to Joseph. The well has great significance to Jewish, Christian and Muslim people as many important conversations happened around her brim.

The one we are highlighting today takes place between Jesus and a Samaritan woman who came in the middle of the day to draw water for her household. Jesus was there resting from his journey and he began the conversation with a request for water. What ensued after that was the longest recorded conversation anyone in the Bible had with Jesus.

Some are more concerned with the character of the woman instead of the words of Jesus. As John Ortberg, the author of our Lenten Book Study entitled "Who is This Man?" states, "Interestingly, the woman's marital history interests Bible scholars much more than it interested Jesus." And he continued, "This woman was poor; she had to draw her own water. Jesus was saying, 'I know you. I know you're a woman, a Samaritan. Your life is very hard. I know your story. I care about you.'"



Jesus met her right where she was and invited her to move into a new way of living. Jesus meets all of us right where we are, but he will not leave us there. He wants all of us to attain a new level of knowledge in spirit and in truth, which can only be gained through a relationship with the one who gives us living water to drink.

Come to the water!

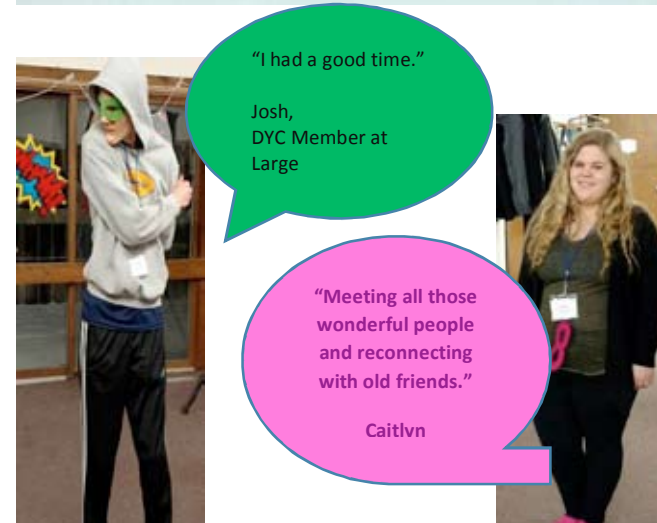

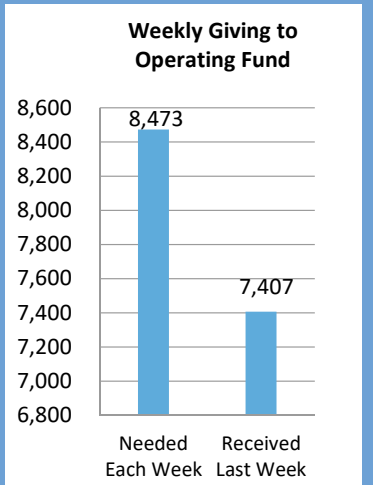

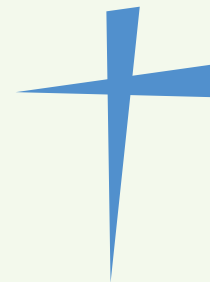
