Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

It boggles my mind to think this is my third celebration of Holy Week, here at PUMC. Each year I invite everyone to be a part of the special services that represent the passion of Christ bookended by the joyful triumphal entry into Jerusalem and the glory of the Risen Christ on Easter. It is wonderful to enjoy the exciting high moments of our Christian faith, however, to fully understand the joy of Easter, it is important to know and better understand the events that happened during his passion in Holy Week.

Maundy Thursday is the day we remember the institution of the Last Supper. "Maundy" is derived from the Latin term for mandate. On the Thursday night that Jesus met for the last time with his disciples, he mandated two things. One, to eat bread and drink wine (juice) as symbols for his body and blood and to do this in remembrance of him. Secondly, he mandated that we be persons of service to one another. He knelt down to wash his disciples' feet, a job usually done by a servant. He demonstrated his love for the others by humbling himself to care for them.

On Thursday at 7:00 pm, we will worship together as a whole with the Chancel Choir sharing music and then be led to two areas to partake of Holy Communion more in the manner of Jesus and his disciples. In tables of 12 we will, wash one another's hands, eat the bread and drink of the cup and share in prayer together. I hope you will come and remember this night when Jesus gave himself up for each of us.

Good Friday is our day of salvation. Jesus died on the cross so that we all might be saved from our sin. He gave his life for us, each one of us and did so willingly and lovingly. At 7:00 pm a very unique service will begin with worship together and music supplied by our wonderful Men's Chorus. Following that the lights will be put out and our youth will bring the powerful story of the life of Jesus while building a cross of candles held by the kids. Then, as the passion story is read, the candles will be extinguished until all will be in darkness. You will not forget this powerful service and the young people who are so dedicated to making it meaningful. I hope you will join us!

Then on Easter Sunday we will celebrate the Risen Son at the rising of the sun. Gathering at 6:30am with song, prayer and praise, we will welcome the Day of Resurrection at its beginning. 8:30 and 10:00 services will be filled with joy, wonderful music, and great celebration, practice your "Hallelujah Chorus!" 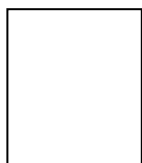
