Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

You are here today to worship God with these young leaders; disciples of Jesus Christ who are already making a difference in the world. I love our youth and am so proud to be their pastor. Pray for them, encourage them in their faith, and listen carefully, because they have much to teach all of us.
