There are always barriers that make it difficult for people to come to church. Some of them are spiritual, some theological, some have to do with one's physical condition, and some are actual physical barriers.

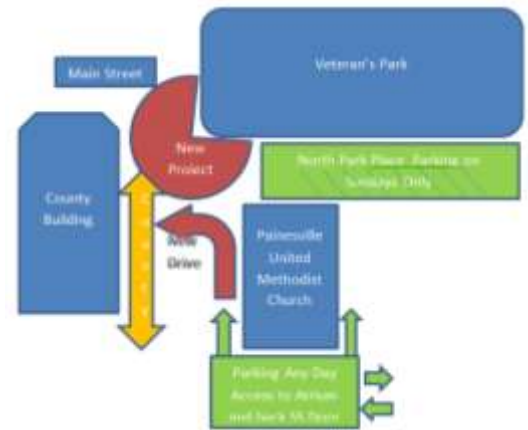
Over the next 2 months we will have some physical barriers to deal with as we come to PUMC. The city of Painesville will be redoing the north east corner of the square beginning **TOMORROW!** This means that we will need to come in the back entrance of the church for **ALL** activities. (That is the entrance that is posted as being "Exit Only", please disregard that sign, but keep your eyes peeled as it is a one car apron. **ON SUNDAYS** we will be able to drive the wrong way down North Park Place and park in front of the church and the courthouse for worship.

At the same time, the county will be finishing the retaining wall and turning our front driveway to the east where it will align with the new county office building driveway.

When all is finished there will be a brick street around the north east corner of the square, shorter cross walks from one side to the other, and one new apron from North Park Place to the county building and the church.

The proposed deadline for completion for the project is July 15.
