## Sunday, November 12, 2017 "Back to the Basics: Rising?"

Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Yesterday was the official day to celebrate our veterans. Today we will share a bit about those who returned from places of war. There are fewer and fewer who can tell us firsthand about the atrocities of WWII; some who can help us better understand Korea; others who know about Vietnam; and many who have returned from the Middle East, and other places more recently. Whether the battles took place in a "war," a "conflict," an "intervention," or a "military protection policy," those who came back have seen, heard and experienced the very worst and the very best of humanity. Some have been able to cope, others have had to find ways to cope, and for some those ways have been helpful, for others devastating. For those who returned we are thankful to God. For those who did not, we mourn their lives, but honor their sacrifice.

I have been fortunate in my life, my father had a bad heart and could not fight, my brother was just one year too young to be drafted, Jim's vision would have kept him out of the military if called, and our son was not of age to join up for Desert Storm. Thus, I do not know firsthand the anxiousness of waiting for a loved one to return home from harm's way. I do not know the fear every time a car pulls up in the drive or the phone rings with an unknown number.

So today, I want to not only honor our veterans, but to also honor the families of those who served. Thank you, thank you all, for the sleepless nights, the hours of prayer, and the strength it took to allow your soldiers to walk away from you, not knowing if they would ever return.

To our veterans and their families, thank you. God bless you all.

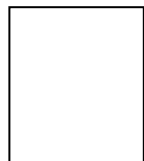
