Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

I am so excited to be able to see some of you in the sanctuary this Sunday. Again, I want to emphasize that though we are taking every precaution we can, there will be some who do not yet feel comfortable gathering indoors. I totally understand and do not want you to do anything that might make you feel uncomfortable. Please continue to watch on Livestream or listen on the radio.

For those who do plan to attend, here are the instructions for the morning for both the 8:15 and the 10:00 services. Please do not arrive too early for the 10:00 service as we will be cleaning the pews, doors, etc. between services.

1. Please use only the **EAST DOORS** to **ENTER** the building. (The Driveway side)
2. If you **need the elevator use the atrium doors**, if not you may come in the wooden doors near the sanctuary.
3. Please **stay at least 6 Feet** from anyone who is not a member of your household.
4. You **MUST wear a face covering** of some kind and leave it on while you are in the building.
5. Please **Sanitize Hands** upon entering.
6. Those **by yourselves** or those who are **couples** living in the same place must sit on the **main floor** of the sanctuary. Those with **family members of 3 or more** must sit in the **balcony**.
7. You will find the pews have been taped off, so that the **only available seating is at the ends of every other pew**. You may not be able to sit where you are used to sitting, but you will be in the sanctuary. As I tell my work mission teams, "It's an MGE (Magic Growth Experience!)"
8. There will be **no hymnals**. All information will be on the screen above the altar.
9. **During hymns**, please **remain seated**, singing quietly or humming, and wearing your mask. Some have found they get light-headed and we don't want anyone fainting! Disregard Wesley's rule to sing loudly!!
10. The **informational bulletins with announcements must be taken home** with you. Do not leave them at the church.
11. You will **EXIT** the building by the **FRONT DOORS** or through the kitchen if you need the elevator.
