Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

I asked the Tuesday Evening Bible Study people why they came to Bible Study? The answers varied: some wanted to be closer to God, some wanted to learn more about scripture, some liked the new perspectives given by people in the group, some came to enjoy the fellowship and discussion. Bible Study is a way **to enrich one's faith through a better understanding of the book which teaches us about God, God's son Jesus, and the Holy Spirit.** The 14 regulars in the Tuesday night group have found joy in the fellowship and knowledge in participating in the interactive discussion as we go through a variety of books, line by line.

The scriptures from both the Hebrew Bible (The Old Testament) and the New Testament are **filled with history, stories, laws, and lessons reflecting the writers' relationships with God.** We, as Christians, look to the Hebrew Bible as important background material aiming us to the acceptance of Jesus as our Lord and Messiah. The New Testament, then, leads us to salvation through the teachings and promises of Jesus.

The fact that the Bible has been on the best seller list for nearly 1800 years is amazing. **And it is a testimony to the power of God's word for all generations. I hope you will consider** participating in a Bible Study group sometime. If you want to start a new group, let the church know and we will get it scheduled. The Bible is not always easy to understand, but it is important to try, and it is easier in a group.
