Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Do you remember when you received your first Bible? I remember **having a great big "Children's Bible" that must have come from the church** because my twin sister and I both had one. It was almost bigger than we were, but had beautiful illustrations of all the well-known stories: **Adam and Eve, Noah's Ark, Jesus' birth, the resurrection, and many more.** I have read many other Bibles in my lifetime, but it all started with that one.

Today we are giving our third graders their own Bibles, they are a little easier to carry than my first, but have the same stories to guide them, the same promises to give them hope and comfort. The illustrations are different in this Bible, and they have a lot more little help sections that make it easier to understand. But the thing that is most important about any Bible is that it is only useful when opened and read. I pray that habit will start early for these children.

I glanced around my office and counted 23 Bibles on shelves or in drawers. Most of them are rather tattered, some of them are old family Bibles, still others are ones I picked up just to have an extra one or two around. **If you do not have a personal Bible, let me know, I'll find you one. It's been on the best seller list since it was compiled about 1800 years ago.** You can find almost anything about which you might want to read: science, history, poetry, non-fiction, love-stories, war-stories, instructions for living, instructions for dying, scandals, heroes, tidbits of wisdom, and promises of God, plus much, much more. Open it up and begin to enjoy the blessings of the Bible!
