What a beautiful sign of resurrection and promise of new life! A glorious reminder that just as Jesus rose again, we all will rise out of this crazy year a bit more aware of our blessings and stronger in our faith.

I have changed the scripture for today a couple of times, striving to find the words that tell us of the power of unity which now more than ever is needed in our church, in our country and in our world. Paul's letter to the Ephesians speaks strongly to the responsibility we, as Christians, have in "...maintaining the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace."
