Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Paul wrote to the Philippians, "Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus." Oh only if we were that good! Sometimes things just seem a little (or a lot) out of our league! I don't think I could ever have the same "mind as Christ," never. But wait a minute, Paul gives us some examples that actually are doable! "Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility regard others as better than yourselves." Hmmm? I can do that. 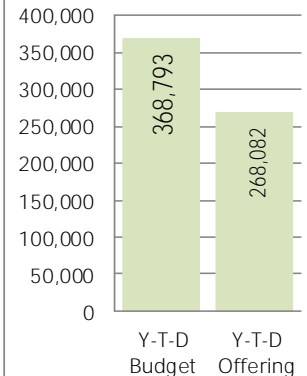
