Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Last Sunday when I returned to my office following worship, I found a gift lying on my desk. It was the book, which I am reading to the children this morning. **"The Tale of Three Trees"** is a folktale retold by Angela Elwell Hunt and this particular copy is beautifully illustrated by Tim Jonke.

As you will hear at Children's Time, it is the story of three trees that had great aspirations to be something very important when they grew up. But when they were cut down, they were made into very modest things without the grandeur of which they had dreamed. Yet God used each of them to do very important things even in their humble state.

When James and John asked Jesus about sitting at his right and left hand when they entered his glory, these were also aspirations of grandeur welling up from pride and arrogance. So Jesus had to explain to them that their greatness would only come when they humbled themselves to be a servant of all. That turned their idea of greatness on its head.

I think it probably does the same for many of us today. Yet, that is still the message, **as the children's song goes, "If you want to be great in God's kingdom, learn to be a servant of all!"**
