"Back to the Basics: Witnessing"

Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Often things get turned around in striving to live a Christian life. What the world thinks is wrong, might just be right, and what the world sees as right, **might just be wrong. Well, the same may be said for the word "Witness."** To the world it means to see something, to observe an event or an incident. **But to a Christian, the word "Witness" is all about taking what has been seen and sharing it with the world.**

One can witness the love of God when they have observed an act of kindness, but they are not yet a witness for God until they tell someone else about it. Someone might be a spectator at a worship service praising Jesus, but they are not a witness to Christ until they share that service of praise with another person.

A witness of faith is much like a witness in a court room. We are asked to tell others what **we have seen or experienced, telling "the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth, so help us God!"** When we are witnesses of our faith the truth becomes clearer to others because of what we say. The world so desperately needs to know the truth of God's love, we must be willing to share that love verbally and in action, thereby becoming witnesses for God.

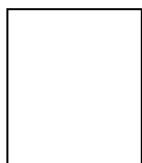
