Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

**Today's scripture is the classic story of the blind man named Bartimaeus.** Jesus heals him, not by packs of mud on his eyes, not with surgery, or removal of cataracts, but responding to his request, **"My Teacher, let me see again."** **Vision is a funny thing; sometimes it means physical sight, sometimes mental images, and sometimes projected ideas.** Bartimaeus could not see physically, but when he heard Jesus coming, he certainly had mental images and a clear vision of the future.

I have known many a person who could physically see perfectly, but had lost their ability to have a vision for the future. Sometimes I wonder which would be worse. It would be hard for me to imagine not being able to see the beauty of the trees as they put on their fall colors, or the sunset that casts its glow upon the rippling waters. But to not have any vision of what the future might look like, or have any dreams of what it could be, would be much more difficult for me.

**Perhaps our prayer to begin each day should be a simple, "My Teacher, let me see again." So that we go into our day with our eyes wide open, our minds cleared for imagination, and our hearts ready to envision a future beginning with that moment.**
