Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Well....we are going to try again to have worship inside beginning next Sunday as long as levels don't flare up again. The Task Force feels we have the safety measures in place to have people flow through the building with the least amount of contact possible and we have people who are willing to clean after the 8:15 service. Below you will find the information you need to make the worship experience the very safest it can be for all. But the Task Force also wants you to know that no one needs to feel obligated to come or will be harassed for not attending. YOU need to make the choice according to your own level of comfort, your vulnerability due to pre-existing conditions or your inability to comply with our safety precautions and protocol. So, beginning next Sunday, October 11 at 8:15 and at 10:00 PUMC will open our doors for IN-PERSON worship with the following guidelines.

1. Please use only the **EAST DOORS** to **ENTER** the building. (The Driveway side)
2. If you need the elevator use the atrium doors, if not you may come in the wooden doors near the sanctuary.
3. Please stay at least 6 Feet from anyone who is not a member of your household.
4. You **MUST** wear a face covering of some kind and leave it on while you are in the building.
5. Please Sanitize Hands upon entering.
6. Those by yourselves or those who are couples living in the same place must sit on the main floor of the sanctuary. Those with family members of 3 or more must sit in the balcony.
7. You will find the pews have been taped off, so that the only available seating is at the ends of every other pew. You may not be able to sit where you are used to sitting, but you will be in the sanctuary. As I tell my work mission teams, "It's an MGE (Magic Growth Experience!)"
8. There will be no hymnals. All information will be on the screen above the altar.
9. During hymns, please remain seated, singing quietly or humming, and wearing your mask. Some have found they get light-headed and we don't want anyone fainting! Disregard Wesley's rule to sing loudly!!
10. The informational bulletins with announcements must be taken home with you. Do not leave them at the church.
11. You will **EXIT** the building by the **FRONT DOORS** or through the kitchen if you need the elevator.
