Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Thanks again to the Stewardship Committee, the Finance Committee, **Reverend Marvin Brown, the church staff, and all who made last Sunday's** Consecration Day possible. We had a wonderful response, a nice lunch, and outstanding results. If you were not able to be there last week, we hope you heard the good news of increased giving, and positive commitment to the ministry of Painesville United Methodist Church, and want to be a part of **God's mission as it is making a way from these walls to God's world.**

Today, World Communion Sunday, is yet another reminder that one person, one church, one **body of Christ, can make a huge difference in the world.** In Tuesday Evening's Bible Study last week we took a close look at 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 12. Paul refers to the church as the body of Christ and reminds us that just like the physical body, this spiritual body needs everyone to work together so that it functions properly. Take a good look at your hands, they do not function like your heart, or like your ears, but each has a specific purpose and the body only works to its full potential when all parts are functioning together with energy and joy.

The scripture for today is often read on Ascension Sunday, when Jesus is being raised up to heaven to sit at the right hand of God. Gathered around him were eleven disciples, eleven! The first church I pastored had twelve in the beginning and I thought we were doing well to triple in size in one year. But look what happened when these eleven did what Jesus asked them (and all of us) to do! That was just a little less than 2,000 years ago and today we celebrate Holy Communion with 2.2 billion others who are sharing the cup and bread **because eleven disciples followed instructions: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you." And they did it because** Jesus promised to be with them. And he is still keeping that promise with us!
