Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Sometimes we overthink too many things. We think we have to list all the details when one simple phrase will be sufficient. Jesus narrowed down 613 laws into two. Love the Lord your God with all your heart, mind, soul, and strength, and love your neighbor as yourself. Paul took up that cry in the letter to the Romans. There was plenty of political and spiritual angst at that time, but he told the people that if they loved one's neighbor as Jesus taught, they would be living into the law of the land and of the Lord.

As we continue to hear news of the hurricanes slamming the south, we need to remember. Our neighbors are not just those who live in our community, but all people around the globe who have been made in the image of God. When our neighbors are suffering, we suffer. When our neighbors are in need, our love must reach out to help meet that need. When our neighbors are in need of prayer, we must pray without ceasing.

Love your neighbor as yourself, the first in our series of "Back to the Basics of Being in Christ." As the apostle Paul states, "Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore, love is the fulfilling of the law."

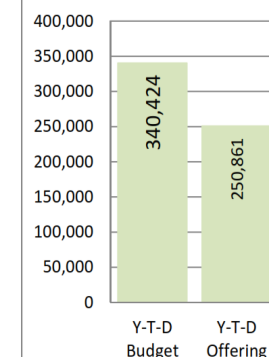
