Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

We have been so fortunate to have had two beautiful Sunday mornings to have our 8:15 worship in Veteran's Park. I am so grateful to the staff that has been so willing to come out early and get set up and then whisk the stuff back to the church for the 10:00 on-line and on-the-air service. It has been wonderful to see people we know and to have visitors come and share in our time together.

I know many are anxious to be back together in worship inside the beautiful building of PUMC, as are we. For those who wish to be with people, come join us at 8:15. For those who wish to be in the church, come visit the church on any week day, sit in the sanctuary for prayer, time it with Jerry Marshall's organ practice (usually in the late morning) and enjoy the music. Find what it is that feeds your soul and pursue it until we can meet together again.

I was listening to Governor Dewine today and he had a doctor from the Cleveland Clinic explain the three things that make the difference in what is safe and what is not. 1. Time (the amount of time people are together in any activity) 2. Space (the size of the place people are meeting in correlation to the number of people present) and 3. People (how many places have people come from to gather together and what is their vulnerability) And of course he emphasized the importance of wearing masks.

When we think of church we think of gathering together for an hour or more, then meeting for fellowship, hugging and shaking hands with all. Though our sanctuary is large and can hold several at safe distances, our hallways (entrances and exits) and restrooms are not. And out of our 180 average attendees, they are coming from over 70 places, with the potential to being exposed to the virus in a wide variety of ways. Not to mention that many of our regular attendees are in high risk categories due to age or physical concerns.

That is why for now, our outdoor service in the park is special. It eliminates the space issue, cuts down on the time spent and when people are social distancing as they can in the park and wearing masks, where they have been before coming is not as important. As the weather changes, this protocol will change as well. We will keep you posted on what we are doing to ensure the safest and best way to worship possible. Thanks for your patience. And be thankful we have live stream and radio capabilities.
