Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Nick began his message last week about how we often judge people by their appearance. It is true, but now with social media we often are left judging people by their words without any idea how they might look. Words can be both inflammably caustic and incredibly comforting, but when they are only on the written page, it is difficult to know the inflection which might be used when spoken.

The subtitle to the passage for today is, "Taming the Tongue" and James writes that it is almost impossible to do so unless one is perfected in love. What one says does matter, what one types on social media does make a difference, what one speaks of another does become fact when heard by others.

To tame the tongue means that we must think through our words before we throw them out into the world. We must use words that encourage and uplift, not ones that discourage and beat down. We must constantly be aware that what we say today cannot return to our mouths but most certainly can return to our hearts.

In taming a wild animal, the trainer must use repetition, expecting the right action, and repeating it over and over. So too it is with the tongue, we must practice using the right words and repeating them over and over.

Here are some examples of the right words, "Thank you," "I'm sorry," "Let me help you," and "I love you!"
