Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

As we begin our five week series on "My Purpose in the Kingdom," focusing on the five vows we take in membership, it is my hope that we will all secure a richer understanding of what it means to be a **part of God's family, not just in this congregation, but in the greater realm of God's reign.**

We start with prayer. Jesus spent much of his time in prayer, or at least he tried. He was often interrupted by crowds crying out for healing, asking about forgiveness, wanting to hear another parable. Finding time to pray was tough, even for Jesus. The first disciples who began growing together in faith and purpose did so by **"devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and the prayers."** Jesus taught the disciples how to pray by using what has become known as **"The Lord's Prayer."** Today, we will come to know that prayer a little better and stress the need to use prayer in our daily lives!
