Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

What does it mean to serve one another in the name of Jesus Christ? Well, it means far too much to put on a piece of paper and speak about on a Sunday morning! 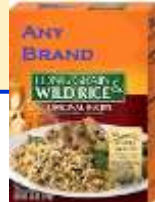
