**"Back to the Basics: Living"**

Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Bob Brown called the other day and asked about playing "What's it All About, Alfie?" for the offertory after reading the theme for the day. What a perfect song for the subject of living and particularly living in Christ! The question about living is often "What's it all about?"

Paul ponders the same thing from a prison cell as he writes to the church in Philippi. He is working through the reality that he may be able to live life in the free world again, or he may end up dying in prison for the sake of the gospel of Jesus Christ. While lying on that cold ground either might have seemed a positive alternative, yet, in living Paul has the opportunity to show others...what it is all about.

The "it" being life and the "about" being love. Paul had visited the Philippians on his second trip and the church was founded at that time. Paul had heard there had been some dissension and wanted to be sure the people of Philippi knew his expectation for living a life "in a manner of the gospel of Christ."

We will never have Paul visit us, as he expected to return to Philippi, so we need to strive for the life he is teaching and do it on our own accord, not because someone might be checking up on us. "What's it all about,... PUMC?" Burt Bacharach had an idea.

*"What's it all about, Alfie? Is it just for the moment we live?  
What's it all about when you sort it out, Alfie? Are we meant to take more than we give?  
Or are we meant to be kind.*

*And if only fools are kind, Alfie, then I guess it's wise to be cruel.  
And if life belongs only to the strong, Alfie, what will you lend on an old golden rule?  
As sure as I believe there's a heaven above, Alfie, I know there's something much more.  
Something even non-believers can believe in. I believe in love, Alfie.*

*Without true love we just exist, Alfie, until you find the love you've missed you're nothing, Alfie.  
When you walk let your heart lead the way and you'll find love any day, Alfie, Alfie."*
