



FINED FOR . . . WHAT?! From the Baxter Bulletin dated March 16, 1906 Circuit court convened Monday with Judge J.W. Meeks presiding and Prosecuting Attorney Thomas I. Hernn present for the state. The Grand Jury was empanelled (yes, this is how they spelled impaneled) and charged and took up its duties at once with A.W. Wickersham as foreman and R.C. Love as clerk.

Among the cases were the following:

Bud Webber, Sabbath breaking; plead [sic] guilty and was fined \$25.

Lee Webber, Sabbath breaking; plead [sic] guilty and was fined \$25.

George Daniels, Sabbath breaking; nol pros.

William Meade, profanity; nol pros.

William Meade, breach of peace; plead [sic] guilty and was fined \$5.

Lewis Creel, profanity; plead [sic] guilty and was fined \$1

Frank Deatherage, petty larceny, plead [sic] guilty and was fined \$10 and one minute in jail.
