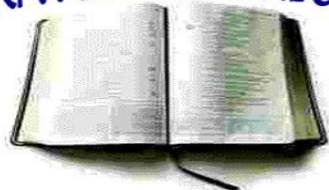
Thirty (30) volunteers from CCMH are needed at **9:30 a.m. on Thursday, March 10**, to prepare **15,000** food packages to be donated to our next-door neighbor, the Mountain Home Food Basket. The food packages will be assembled here in our Worship Center.

The food items will be purchased from Pac-Sac, a Christian ministry group, by Sean Taylor, owner of Private Financial Company. The staff of Private Financial will bring 10 volunteers to help with the project. Our elders have agreed that CCMH will provide the space for the work, and we want to provide the additional 30 volunteers from our church.

The packaging project runs from 9:30 until noon, after which a catered lunch will be provided for volunteers. NOTE: Making the food packages requires standing at tables, so volunteers need to be able to do that. So please set aside that Thursday morning, March 10, to join in and help feed the hungry and touch our community in the name of Jesus.

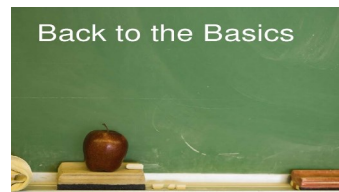
